We moved from Bloomington, IN to the Michigan City campground, and into our travel trailer, on July 1<sup>st</sup>. We haven't had Internet most of that time, which has made sending updates difficult. We want to catch you up on what's happening.

#### MINISTRY:

In June we were involved in evangelistic outreach, RIBI board of director's business, and setting up visits with supporters. July finds us visiting some of our supporting churches and families. We will be involved in another evangelistic endeavor July 29-Aug 1. Pray for us as we continue our contacts and relationships with people in the vintage trailer group that weekend. We have been able to share the gospel on a couple of occasions, and Bill served as chaplain at a rally in June. Pray for opportunities to share the Gospel!

In August we will also be visiting some of our supporting churches, including Liberty Bible Church, South Suburban Bible Church, and Palos Bible Church.

We will be returning to Latvia on Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>. The luggage allowances have changed and we will be allowed only ONE 50 pound suitcase each on the return trip, unless we want to pay \$50 extra each for more than that. This really cuts into our ability to bring things back to Latvia for our friends there. We'll do our best, however. We will be teaching 4 classes for RIBI this fall, and Bill will also be teaching for the Baltic Pastoral Institute. We'll have more on all that later.
